

# Make your own Last Wolf Tree House

*Fiddliness level: unbelievable*

First, print out your tree shapes and inside bits onto card (or print on paper and stick onto card.)

Cut everything out.

You can score along the lines where you are going to fold things to make better folds. An old used-up biro and ruler is good for this.

Cut the door in your tree and fold along the dotted side.

If you are making the non-coloured version, now's the time to colour your tree and your door and your inside room. Invent your own Wolf Portraits!

Make leaves and stick them on.

You can use lots of different coloured paper scraps, or colour your own and cut them out.

Colour your door. Make a hole in the centre and push through a brass paper fastener for the door knob. Stick your door onto the door shape in your tree. Stick on your *More Trees Please* sign.

Now it's time to attach your room!

Fold the two side tabs and the three bottom tabs. Using glue or double-sided tape, glue the two side tabs to the back of your tree trunk.

Your room should make a curved shape.

Now cut the slits in your base.

Push your bottom room tabs through the three slots in your base and glue them down on the underneath.

Now your tree should stand up.

Lastly cut out your characters (or make your own) and get them to stand up. Use the stands here, or invent your own way.
